

**VISIT TO ANGELS COSTUMES
MORRIS ANGEL & SON LTD., 1 GARRICK ROAD, LONDON NW9 6AA
THURSDAY, JULY 12TH AT 2.30 P.M.**

In 1813 Daniel Angel, a young tailor from Frankfurt, arrived in London with barely a word of English. He headed for Seven Dials and set up a barrow selling second hand clothes and later opened a second hand clothing shop, with his son Morris, providing a service for those who wanted good quality clothes at reasonable cost. Later the hire business took off. I knew the shop in Shaftesbury Avenue which is famous for the hire of fancy dress and used to provide services for West End productions. Then came costumes for films.

In 2002 the firm moved to a purpose-built facility in Hendon. The building includes costume rental, line-up, costume making facilities and over 8 miles of costume rails. The tour will take you to see the workshops where new items are stitched. You will also see the 8 miles of costume rails, including costumes from all manner of plays, films and shows such as Downton Abbey.

The cost per person is £20.

The building is very close to the end of the M1, the North Circular and the A5 junction. Parking is available on site. The closest station is Hendon (overland) 5 minutes walk and Hendon Central (Northern Line) 15-20 minutes walk. For a map visit <http://www.angels.uk.com/contact>.
