

VISIT TO NATIONAL GRID CONTROL CENTRE,
WARWICK
THURSDAY OCTOBER 12th

Those REA members who attended our AGM on March 16th will have heard a very interesting presentation given by Richard Pickup about the history of the control of the high pressure gas network from its beginning until the present day.

We have now received an invitation for up to 30 REA members to visit the Control Centre at Warwick on Thursday 12th October to see and hear from the grid controllers how the centre works. The visit will also include lunch.

The visit starts at 11.30am and finishes at 15.00pm, so that members travelling by train can catch the 9.40am Chiltern Train from London Marylebone to Warwick and the 15.42 Chiltern train from Warwick to return. If you travel by another train company you should allow time to be at Warwick around 11.00am.

Please Note that the Chiltern Trains to and from Warwick run once an hour at these times.

There is no charge for the visit but you will have to find your own way to and from Warwick. If you wish to drive to Warwick please let me know so that arrangements for parking can be made.

I will not give the Control Centre address here but I will give directions to those members who say that they would like to go nearer to the time.
